Report on Compliance of the Directions given by the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity in their Order dated 17th December, 2009 in Review Petition no. 5 of 2009 in Appeal No. 181 of 2008

This report contains the status on the implementation of the directions given by the Hon'ble Tribunal to the Secretary to the Forum of Regulators in its Order dated 17th December, 2009 (copy at Annexure – I) in Review Petition no. 5 of 2009 in Appeal No. 181 of 2008. The report is divided into three sections dealing with the following three directions given by the Tribunal:

- I. The Secretary to the Forum of Regulators was directed that it shall take up the issue of constitution, appointment and operationalisation of the State Electricity Regulatory Commissions for the States of Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh by getting sufficient help and cooperation from Secretary to the Union Ministry of Power.
- II. The second direction to the Secretary to the Forum of Regulators was to ensure full compliance of the provision of the Electricity Act, 2003 in respect of Section 42(5) regarding Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum in certain states as mentioned in the Order.
- III. The third direction to the Secretary to the Forum of Regulators was to ensure full compliance with regard to constitution and appointment of Electricity Ombudsman in certain states as mentioned in the Order of the Tribunal dated 9th October, 2009.

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SECTION - I

Status on the directions of the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity regarding functionalisation of the State Electricity Regulatory Commissions

Section 82 of the Electricity Act, 2003 provides that 'Every State Government shall, within six months from the appointed date, by notification, constitute for the purposes of this Act, a Commission for the State to be known as the (name of the State) electricity Regulatory Commission'. It was noticed by the Tribunal that the SERCs for the States of Sikkim & Arunachal Pradesh were not in compliance to the provisions of this section. The details of the steps taken by Secretary, Forum of Regulators and current status are as follows:

The Chief Secretaries of the Govt. of Sikkim & Arunachal Pradesh were again requested by the Secretary to the Forum of Regulators through D.O. letters (Copies at Annexure – II) that necessary action should be taken for functionalization of the State Electricity Regulatory Commissions in their respective States. As directed by the Hon'ble Tribunal, the Secretary, Ministry of Power was also approached directly (copy of letter at Annexure – III) with a request for his intervention to take up the matter at the appropriate level with the states of Sikkim & Arunachal Pradesh.

It would be pertinent to mention here that the Secretary to the Forum of Regulators also spoke to the Energy Secretaries of the Govt. of Sikkim & Arunachal Pradesh over phone on this matter. In addition to this, both the states were also reminded (copies at Annexure – IV). A letter was also sent to Ministry of Power (Copy at Annexure – V). Telephonically it was gathered that the Ministry of Power had earlier written to the State of Arunachal Pradesh to expedite setting up of SERC. Secretary, Energy of Arunachal Pradesh told that it is under active consideration of the State Government. Secretary Energy, Sikkim told that they will soon send the current status. The written replies in this regard are still awaited.

SECTION - II

Status on the directions of the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity regarding Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum

This section of the report deals with the action taken by the respective State Electricity Regulatory Commissions with respect to the CGRFs in their states. The Chairpersons of SERCs were requested to take action for implementation of directions and send the status of compliance. The current status has been tabulated below on the basis of information received from the respective SERCs/JERCs (copies of letters received are placed at Annexure - VI):
